

QUALIFICATIONS FOR FLIGHT ACHIEVEMENT BADGES

MODEL WIFE - Silver - Board discretion.

INSTRUCTOR - Black - Apply to Board, at their discretion.

CROSS COUNTRY TEAM - Blue - Either pilot or pit crew assistant on a successful cross country flight during a club cross country event.

NIGHT FLYER - Black - Successful flight of a model aircraft during the hours of darkness where lights on the aircraft are the prime source of model location/orientation.

FLOAT FLYER - Green - B.O.M. rule applies. Successful flight from water that begins and ends with the weight of the model Wholly supported by the water.

SPORTS SCALE - Orange - AMA R/C Fun Scale rules apply. Must attain an average score of six points per maneuver as judged by three TRCC members.

FAN JET PILOT - Red - B.O.M. rule applies successful flight of fan-jet model.

MULTI ENGINE PILOT - Yellow - B.O.M. rule applies. Successful flight of model aircraft with two or more engines operating.

MULTI WING PILOT - Dark Blue - B.O.M. rule applies. Successful flight of any aircraft with two or more wings,

EXPERT SCALE PILOT - Gold - Pick out twelve maneuvers from the AMA handbook, scale section, perform those maneuvers and be judged in execution by recognized, experienced TRCC scale judges and score a seven or above as an average throughout the flight.

SENIOR PILOT - A senior pilot is an honorary award. The member should be capable of Level II performance and be able to successfully fly almost any model airplane. He is the member who consistently and cheerfully gives of his time and skill to help other pilots achieve a higher degree of efficiency. He is the member who, unasked, takes on any additional task to make TRCC a better organization. He is readily available to work any and all club functions.

To become a senior pilot a member is nominated by either the Board or the floor during a regular meeting. Members present must vote unanimously in favor for this award to be given.
