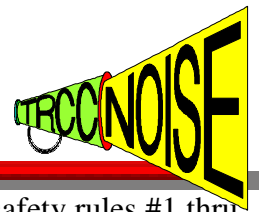

Always flight check your aircraft. #3. You must have a frequency indicator on your radio. Same exception for 2.4 GHz radio. #4. Never start your engine under the ramada. #5. Make sure your airplane nose is pointed toward the ramadas so that air rush from propeller goes toward the runway. #6. Do not stand in front of or beside a running prop.
