PARK ZONE T-28 TROJAN

This is a shaped foam electric model, not a flat foamy. It comes complete needing only a radio and a 3 cell LiPo battery. Hobby Barn price is approximately \$172 plus tax. There is a model available that includes the radio, battery and charger and is priced around \$240 plus tax.

No glue used in preparing it for flight. Only two problems. The battery plug on supplied ESC needs replacing with a more compatible Deans plug. So a couple of minutes with a soldering gun and a new male Deans plug cures that. Don't forget to connect the red and black wires to the correct pins on the connector.

The other minor problem is the 3 mm wing hold down screw that goes into the wing in a plastic insert. The insert has a long plastic tube to guide the screw. Mine was approximately 3/16" to long. A zona saw quickly
